

DATA COLLECTION AND PROCESSING CONSENT

When you enter and participate in an EHF officiating activities (henceforth "Activities"), your participation shall be governed by the under specified terms, the rules of the relevant activity (henceforth "Activity") and any other materials relating to the activities published on the relevant EHF Platform.

Informative and explanatory material relating to any activities developed by or connected with the EHF form part of this consent form.

Organisation of ebt Tournaments, requiring the processing of Personal Data on data subjects for the purposes of formulating participation records on ebt Tournaments and sending invitations for any upcoming events.

In cooperation with **Local Organising Committees** (the "Ocs")

1. General Information

The European Handball Federation (EHF), Hoffingergasse 18, A-1120 Vienna, has contracted with the OCs toward the organization of EHF ebt Tournaments and therefore the EHF is the controller of the data processed whereas the OCs are acting as processors, in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

2. Categories of Data Subjects

The Personal Data Processed may concern the following categories of Data Subjects (depending on the service provided):

- Natural persons participating in EHF ebt Tournaments.

3. Consent period

The OCs and EHF as well as their respective parent companies, subsidiaries, affiliates, and employees are required to abide by the present terms and applicable GDPR Regulations, and thus allowed to process any collected data accordingly for the duration of Agreements relating to Activities' organisation established between the parties, or in cases of revoked consent.

4. Participation in activities

Participating in the activities requires express user consent within the present terms. When registering with personal user data, the user hereby explicitly acknowledges and agrees to the terms for activities wherein the data subject is participating, and specifically to the data use described hereinunder.

5. Data Privacy

5.1. Use of personal data

The participation in the activities requires the input of first and last names, mobile number and email address, (the “Personal Data”). The Personal Data collected and processed during the subjects’ participation in the activities will be processed by the OCs and EHF in accordance with GDPR and with the applicable Austrian privacy and data protection laws.

By consenting to the collection and processing of your Personal Data, you acknowledge and agree with the terms hereby determined and enforceable in full.

The EHF is authorised to collect, process, save, share, edit and create profiles of the data subjects as per the definition of Article 4 (4) and Articles 6 (a) and 6 (f) of GDPR. Apart from the foregoing, the EHF will only disclose Personal Data if users have given their express consent, if there is a legal obligation to do so, or if this is necessary to enforce the EHF’s rights.

The OCs are authorised to save and process the data collected. The OCs are required to delete the data if ever instructed to do so by the EHF.

The EHF and the OCs use the data for the purpose of formulating participation records on ebt Tournaments and sending invitations for any upcoming events, for which users must expressly agree to the use and forwarding of Personal Data as described herein.

Users may revoke their consent at any time and without providing reasons, with effect for the future. If you revoke your consent to the processing of data, you are no longer entitled to participate in the activities. In order to revoke your consent, please send an email to dpo@eurohandball.com. We may have to ask you for appropriate identification for the purpose of altering your consent specifications.

For detailed information on your rights, you can consult the General Data Protection Regulation.

5.2. Security of Data

EHF and the OCs use all available technical and organizational security measures in order to protect your Personal Data against a breach of security leading to the accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure of, or access to, your Personal Data transmitted, stored or otherwise processed.

It is important to remember that no system can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. We recommend that you help us keep your data safe by taking reasonable steps such as not disclosing sensitive personal data in places that can be accessed publicly.

6. Limitation of liability

The EHF shall not be liable for faults caused by circumstances outside of their control. This applies particularly to impairments resulting from the failure of or interruptions to the telephone communication network or power supply or any leaks of data caused on behalf or in connection to the subject's own actions.

The aforementioned Agreements under Article 3 complies in full with the applicable Data Protection Regulations in place in the European Union i.e. (EU) 2016/679 General Data Protection Regulation.
