



## **EBT Masters Finals** Calling for Organizers

Dear Beach Handball Friends,

On 30 September 10 the EBT season 09/10 will find its end! In order to have enough preparation time we would like to find the organizer of the EBT Masters Finals to be played on 28/29 May 2011 (alternative date to be discussed)!

In the following please find basic information for the organization of EBT Masters Finals.

### **Preconditions**

With reference to the new structure of Beach Handball events the EBT Masters will be used for educating BH referees. The referees will be used for the EBT Masters competition in order to secure a high level of officiating. To apply for the organisation of the EBT Masters means also applying for the organisation of the 2011 BH Further Education Courses from 26 – 29 May 2011 for BH referees (organisational details to be discussed separately).

The EHF Executive Committee will award the organizer of the EBT Masters Finals based on the submitted information in October 2010.

Please fill in both the application paper and the information sheet and submit both to the EHF office by 10 September 10 at the latest.

### **1. Basics:**

<b>Event Period:</b>	Friday, 27 – Monday, 30 May 2010
<b>Date of EBT Masters:</b>	Saturday, 28 – Sunday, 29 May 2010
<b>Participants:</b>	8 men's and 8 women's teams (following the respective EBT ranking) Conditions: first 6 nations, if the first named team of one nation does not use his participation right, the second (third, ...) ranked team of this nation which has send in its registration will be selected. If less than 6 different nations apply, the next ranked team of any nation will be selected. + 1 wildcard each for the organizer + defending champion of the previous EBT Masters Finals (if registered for the running EBT season)

**2. Application:** to the EHF Office **by 10 September 2010** at the latest.

**3. Requirements which shall be fulfilled by the organiser** (should be submitted to the EHF Office together with the application):

a. Venue / Playing courts:

- Outdoor event
- Number of playing courts: 2 (8 men's teams + 8 women's teams)
- Short description of venue (photo)
- Price-offers for accommodation (3 different categories of hotels in walking distance to the event area)
- Infrastructure: electronic score taking and time keeping on both playing courts, water free of charge for the players
- Balls, goals and line systems in case the EHF does not conclude a respective contract with a supplier

b. Services by the organiser

- DVDs of the final matches in each category (should be enclosed in the tournament documentation)
- Internet live streaming (at least from the main court)
- Medals for the teams ranked 1 – 4 in each category
- Prizes for best player, goalkeeper and Fair Play team in each category
- Facilities (meeting rooms, beamer, flipchart) for the BH Further Education Course of referees from 26 – 29 May 2011 (the referees taking part are foreseen to be the referees in the EBT Masters)
- Central Information Centre (CIC): information on match results / ranking
- Guides for each team

**4. Finances**

- The teams have to bear the costs for travel, transfer and accommodation/meals by themselves.
- The organiser have to bear the costs arising from the tournament organisation (playing courts, opening and awarding/closing ceremony, prizes, referees, time keepers, secretaries, volunteers, internet live streaming, etc.).
- The Organiser have to bear the costs for airport transfer and accommodation + full board for the referees taking part in the BH Further Education course
- The organiser shall bear the travel costs, accommodation + full board and daily allowances (€ 55) of max. 5 EHF officials from 25 – 30 May 2011
- The EHF will organise the balls as well as the line systems and the goals for the main court in case the EHF concludes a respective contract with a supplier; transport costs have to be borne by the organiser
