



## ebt Finals Calling for Organizers

Dear Beach Handball Friends,

On 30 September 2014 the ebt season 13/14 found its end! In order to have enough preparation time we would like to find the organizer of the ebt Finals to be played from 22 – 24 May 2015 (alternative date to be discussed)!

In the following please find basic information for the organization of ebt Finals.

### Pre-Conditions

With reference to the new structure of Beach Handball events the ebt Finals will be used for the education of EHF BH referees and EHF BH delegates. The referees and the delegates will be used for the ebt Finals competition in order to secure a high level of officiating. To apply for the organisation of the ebt Finals means also applying for the organisation of the 2015 Further Education Courses from 20 – 24 May 2015 for BH referees and delegates (organisational details to be discussed separately).

The EHF Executive Committee will award the organizer of the ebt Finals based on the submitted information on 20/21 December 2014.

Please fill in both the application and the information sheet and submit both documents to the EHF office by 01 December 2014 at the latest.

### 1. Basics

<b>Event Period:</b>	Tuesday, 19 May – Monday, 25 May 2015
<b>Date of ebt Finals:</b>	Friday, 22 May – Sunday, 24 May 2015
<b>Participants:</b>	10 men's and 10 women's teams (following the respective ebt ranking) Conditions: first 8 nations, if the first named team of a nation does not use its participation right, the second (third, ...) ranked team of this nation, which has sent in its registration will be selected. If less than 8 different nations apply, the next ranked team of any nation will be selected. + 1 wildcard each for the organizer + defending champion of the previous ebt Finals (if registered for the running ebt season)

## 2. Application

to the EHF Office **by 01 December 2014** at the latest.

## 3. Requirements

**which shall be fulfilled by the organiser** (should be submitted to the EHF Office together with the application):

a. Venue / Playing courts:

- Outdoor event
- Number of playing courts: 2 (10 men's teams + 10 women's teams)
- Short description of venue (photo)
- Price-offers for accommodation (3 different categories of hotels in walking distance to the event area); please take note that the participating teams can choose their accommodation freely.
- Infrastructure: electronic score taking and time keeping on both playing courts, water free of charge for the players and WIFI on both courts
- Playing balls, goals and line systems will be provided by the EHF (customs and transport costs for the said material as well as for the adidas clothing for the EHF Officials, referees and delegates have to be borne by the organizer)

b. Services by the organiser


- DVDs of the final matches in each category (should be enclosed in the tournament documentation)
- Internet live streaming (at least from the main court)
- Medals for the teams ranked 1 – 3 in each category
- Commemorative medals and event T-shirt for all participants
- Prizes for most valuable player, goalkeeper, top scorer and Fair Play team in each category
- Facilities (meeting rooms, beamer, flipchart) for the BH Further Education Courses from 20 - 24 May 2015 (the referees and delegates taking part are foreseen to be the referees and delegates in the ebt Finals)
- Central Information Centre (CIC): information on match results / ranking
- Guides for each team

## 4. Finances

- The teams have to bear the costs for travel, transfer and accommodation/meals by themselves.
- The organiser has to bear the costs arising from the tournament organisation (playing courts, opening and awarding/closing ceremonies, prizes, referees, delegates, time keepers, secretaries, volunteers, internet live streaming, etc.).
- The organiser shall bear the travel costs, accommodation + full board and daily allowances (€ 55 per day) for 2 EHF Officials concerning the inspection / workshop planned in January 2015.
- The organiser has to bear the costs for airport transfer and accommodation + full board for 12 - 16 referees (6 - 8 pairs) and 6 - 8 delegates taking part in the BH Further Education courses.
- The organiser shall bear the travel costs, accommodation + full board and daily allowances (€ 55 per day) of max. 5 EHF officials from 19 - 25 May 2015
- The EHF will organise the playing balls as well as the line systems and the goals for both courts - see point 3.
